Description

The DAC 120 was developed for detecting dynamic pressure changes up to 2000 bar in hydraulic systems. The unique $GaPO_4$ sensor element allows a sensitivity of 5.2 pC/bar. It is therefore ideal for resolving small pressure fluctuations across the entire pressure range. The front-sealing sensor in conjunction with the compression fitting is not influenced by either installation or installation position.


